

2019-20 ACA Tuition Discount Policy

Augustine Classical Academy (ACA) is committed to making classical Christian education available to all families, while maintaining its commitment to small class sizes and quality teaching. Consequently, ACA offers the following tuition discounts.

Tuition Assistance is available to any K-12 family who qualifies based on an application to and recommendation from FACTS, a third-party tuition assistance firm. While every enrolling family may apply for tuition assistance, awards, if any, are based upon a variety of factors, including income level, overall assets, and number of children. Tuition assistance is not currently available to Augustine Classical Preschool (ACP) students.

Sibling Discounts are available for all academic programs beginning with the third child. Specific discounted rates can be found directly on our tuition rates sheet.

Church Staff Discounts are available for full-time church staff employed in an orthodox Protestant denomination. Church staff discounts are 15% of overall ACA K-12 tuition. ACP tuition does not currently qualify for this discount. Documentation of employment is required.

Colorado Christian University (CCU) Discounts are available for any full- or part-time CCU staff or faculty. The CCU discount is 20% of overall ACA K-12 tuition. ACP tuition does not currently qualify for this discount. Documentation of employment is required.

Up-Front Payment Discounts are available for any ACP or K-12 families paying tuition in-full (lump sum) for the academic year on or before July 5. The up-front payment discount is 2.5% of total tuition and is applied after any other qualifying discounts are applied. Mailed up-front payments via check must be postmarked on or before July 5, and requests for electronic up-front payment via FACTS must be received via email to info@augustineclassical.org on or before July 5.

Pioneer Discounts are currently closed and are retroactively available only to founding families enrolling before or at the beginning of the fall 2013 academic year. Pioneer discounts are applied after any qualifying sibling discounts are applied and before any up-front discounts are applied. Any families who qualified for the Pioneer Discount when originally offered and who subsequently unenrolled from ACA are not eligible for a renewal of the Pioneer Discount upon re-enrollment at a later date.

Stacking discounts: Stacking or combining any of the above discounts is not available. If a family qualifies for multiple discounts, the single greatest discount amount is automatically applied, unless otherwise requested by the family. However, the following discounts may be combined:

- > The up-front (2.5%) discount and/or sibling discount may be combined with any other single discount.

Waiving discounts: Families may choose to waive any of the above discounts they qualify for (excluding the up-front discount) for a tax deduction. The waived discount(s) will be considered a donation to the Augustine Campaign.
