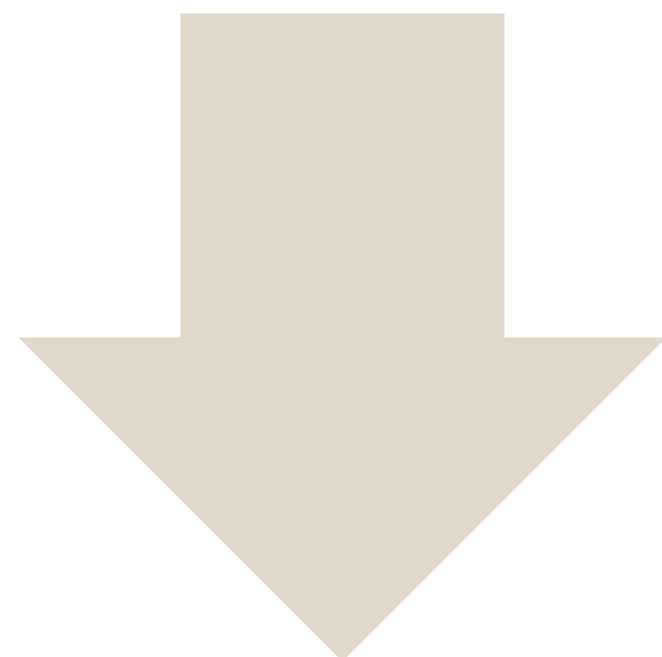

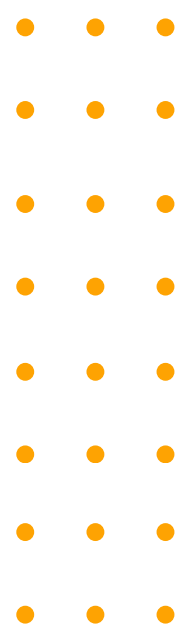
What's Next

Awards and Command Performances

Students are competing against classmates at their grade level. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will be announced for each competition room. Awards will be presented at the assembly. First place winners from 1st through 8th grade will give command performances. The highest scoring student from Logic and Rhetoric School will also give a command performance.

Regional Speech Meet

This year the K-8 regional meet will be hosted by Arma Dei Academy on Friday, March 1st. Competing schools are: ACA, Arma Dei, Arma Dei Homeschool Collaborative (1st - 6th grade), and Summit Classical Academy (1st - 7th grade).



Top performers from ACA's in-house speech meet will be invited to compete at the Regional Speech Meet:

1st & 2nd grades : 1st & 2nd place from each competition room (4 students for 1st, 4 students for 2nd)
3rd - 8th grades: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners (3 students per grade)

Note: Rhetoric students will *not* advance to regionals since the event is K-8th grades only
