ACA recommends families use Logic of English for their language arts curriculum and Saxon for their math curriculum. Suggested grade-level pacing guides are available.

- Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:15 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
- Two classes: Kindergarten-2nd grade/3rd grade 5th grade
- Classes cap at 16 students
- Homeschool students are invited to participate in extracurricular activities offered by the school
