



STANDARDIZED TESTING INFORMATION

Information regarding standardized testing may be found on the [College Board website](#) (CEEBC code: 061508). Tests in Gold are offered at ACA. Tests in Blue are not offered by ACA at this time.

Note that accommodations are available for standardized testing but require documentation from the school and the process for approval can take several weeks. Reach out to the Director of Academics if you have questions.

CLT

Take the CLT as an alternative to the SAT and ACT. CLT scores are accepted at hundreds of colleges across the country, and [CLT vs SAT](#) and [CLT vs ACT](#) conversion charts are available.

From the [CLT website](#): The SAT and ACT are designed to reflect public school curricula, specifically the Common Core State Standards framework. The CLT is different. Instead of evaluating how much students have crammed for the test, CLT considers students' intellectual capacity and aptitude, making it a better fit for students from a variety of educational backgrounds. CLT also uses meaningful pieces of literature for its reading passages to offer a more enjoyable and enriching testing experience.

Note: ACA students take the appropriate level of the CLT in grades 3-10, making this a natural choice for the college entrance exam.

Like the SAT, the PSAT/NMSQT contains reading, math, and writing sections. The PSAT/NMSQT is now only offered digitally, resulting in convenient test-taking, a shorter test, a built-in calculator for the math section, and quicker results delivery.
